- 100% tuition and fees

 - \$300/month Freshman (9 months)
 - \$350/month Sophomore (9 months)
 - \$450/month Junior (10 months)
 - \$500/month Senior (9 months)

 - \$600/semester

Obligations

- During College
 - Classes – These will be held on the MSU campus:
 - Freshman MSL 111/112 1 credit hour
 - Sophomore MSL 211/212 2 credit hours
 - Junior MSL 311/312 3 credit hours
 - Senior MSL 411/412 3 credit hours
 - Physical Training 4x's per week: Mon, Tues, Wed, Thurs, mornings.
 - Lead Lab Thursday afternoon 4-6 p.m.
 - Attend one weekend FTX per semester
 - Attend the Leader Development and Assessment Course between junior and senior year
 - Professional Development Classes --One Military History class required.
- After College
 - Your total service obligation will be eight years. Scholarship winners may incur a four year active duty commitment. If so, you have the option of fulfilling the remaining four years in the Army Reserve, National Guard, or Inactive Ready Reserve.

Active Duty Employment Facts

- Stationed at Army posts across the continental United States, Hawaii, Alaska or around the world
- Starting Salary – approx \$32,947
- Housing Allowance that helps pay your rent. About \$1,000 a month in most areas, but varies depending on where you are stationed.
- Full Medical Coverage for yourself and dependents
