All applicants must submit:

- Completed application form
- \$250 (U.S.) nonrefundable application fee (SEVIS fee included)
- “[Certificate of Financial Responsibility](#)” form and supporting documents
- Autobiographical essay that includes a statement of your personal and academic purpose
- Two letters of recommendation
- Proof of English proficiency. The College recognizes official results from the following standardized tests:
 - TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) minimum score 550 pbt/80 ibt
 - MELAB (Michigan English Language Testing System) minimum score 80
 - IELTS (International English Language Testing Service) minimum score 6.5
 - ELS (English Language School) testing minimum score level 109
 - Global Language Institute www.gli.org — must reach the accelerated level and be recommended for admission
 - ACT or SAT I required if attending an American high school
- Complete official secondary school record listing courses taken, examination results, and class rank, if available. Also include an official English translation.
- A complete record of any college, university, or other post-secondary work listing courses taken and examination results.
- The original or photocopy of any certificate or degree obtained. Please also include an official English translation.
- Complete all application requirements by July 1 for fall term or by October 1 for spring term

- Purchase Medical insurance recommended by BLC
- Two small pictures
